# R.B.C College for Women Student's satisfaction Survey 2022-23

A sample survey of the final (semester-6) year students has been done through questionnaire guidelines by NAAC (National assessment and accreditation council) for Student's Satisfaction Survey. It will help to upgrade the quality of overall education of the institution. The questionnaire includes 20 different areas to grade choice of subjects, application of computers, overall infrastructural facilities (including drinking water, sanitation etc), library facilities, internal evolution systems, adequacy of teachers towards their teaching-communicating-encouraging skills and overall behavioral attitude and ranking their relation with their teachers throughout, students participation in extra-curricular activities and the influence of the teachers on it.

The student's Satisfaction Survey is done among 923 final semester students and 462 students responded of which 84.4% students from humanities and 15.1% from science group.






# <u>The Institute takes initiatives in promoting internships, student exchange, field visit opportunities</u> <u>for students:</u>


# The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth:

### The institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow:









### Was your performance in assignments discussed with you:




#### How well the teachers prepare in the class:







About 57% of students gave opinion that teachers identity their strengths and encourage them providing the right level of challenges.


### The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges:


### How well the teachers able to communicate:


### The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as:


### <u>Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities:</u>



### What percentage of teachers uses ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc, while teaching:


